KEITH BICKEL is the Senior Vice President, Public Policy Executive focusing on mortgage policy for Bank of America in Washington, D.C. In this role, he monitors mortgage-related policy and regulatory change for the Bank's senior executive team; helps shape and define Bank positions on key mortgage-related issues; and engages with external industry trade groups and policymakers to shape policy options and outcomes.

In addition to his policy work, Keith previously led the Bank's affordable and multi-cultural lending group as the Neighborhood Lending Executive. Previously, he led the corporate strategy group there as well. His prior policy career includes positions held at the White House and Pentagon, as well as several entrepreneurial ventures in the data and technology space.
